2010 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

General Information to Applicants

1. This program of college tuition awards is supported by the Gwinnett Soccer Association, Inc. (GSA) in recognition of the contribution youth soccer has made to the development of young people in Georgia.
2. The scholarships are in the form of tuition awards up to \$2,000.00 to be used toward expenses in an accredited college, university, or community college, beginning in the upcoming fall semester.
3. The program is open to those Georgia players currently participating in a bona fide soccer program, including graduating high school seniors, high school graduates who wish to start college, and continuing college students. During their soccer experience, applicants must also have participated on a recreational or select team sponsored by GSA for at least two years.
4. Oral interviews may be conducted for finalists.
5. Successful applicants may be recognized at a formal awards presentation conducted by GSA.
6. Only complete applications (all parts submitted in one package prior to the deadline) will be accepted. All applicants receive notice of the final disposition of their applications as soon as practical after the selection process is completed.
7. Awards are contingent upon proof of acceptance and enrollment in an academic or vocational program at an accredited four-year college, university, or community college with a minimum course load of 12 units in the upcoming fall season.



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APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must submit the following in one completed package (do not send portions separately) to the Gwinnett Soccer Association, Inc., P.O. Box 210, Lilburn, Georgia, 30048, ATTN. Scholarship Committee, to be received at the above address by NO LATER THAN **May 31, 2010.**

1. A completed application form.
2. A copy of applicant's official high school or college transcript.
3. A written statement in the applicant's own words, no longer than one page, outlining personal goals and objectives in college, career ambitions, and any other background information not included in the application which applicant would like to present.
4. Details of the years you played at GSA and the team you played for.
5. A letter of recommendation from applicant's soccer coach (amateur or school).
6. A letter of recommendation from a faculty advisor or teacher (other than athletic).
7. A letter of recommendation from a personal or professional acquaintance (not related to applicant).

(NOTE: The letter of recommendation should include how long and in what capacity the applicant is known, and when appropriate: the applicant's scholastic ability, soccer background, potential success in college and in career goals, and other factors which the writer feels should be considered.)
